Mathletics

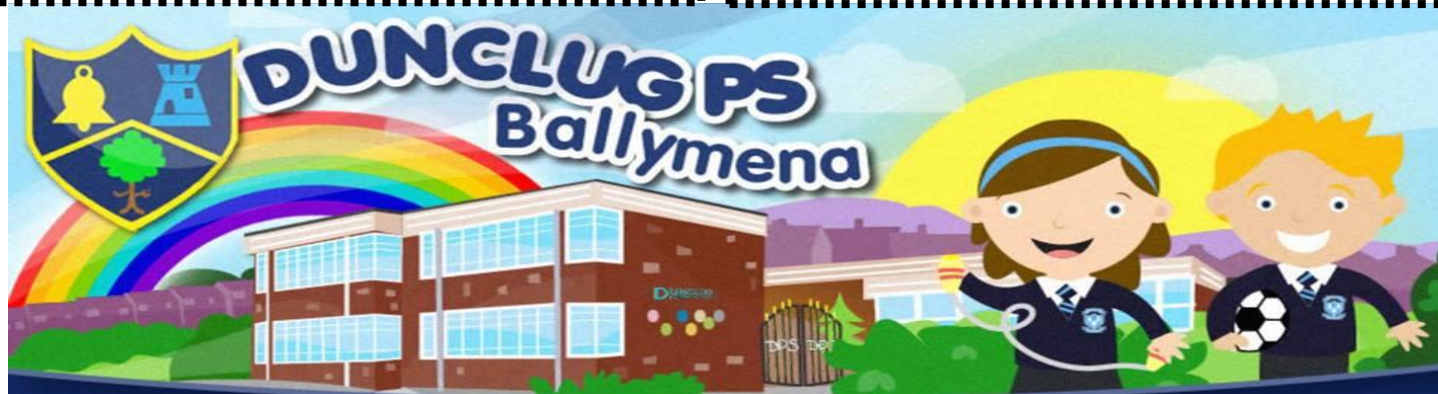

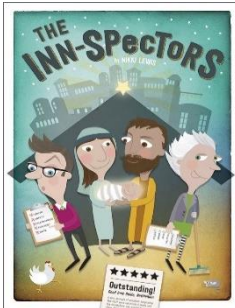
